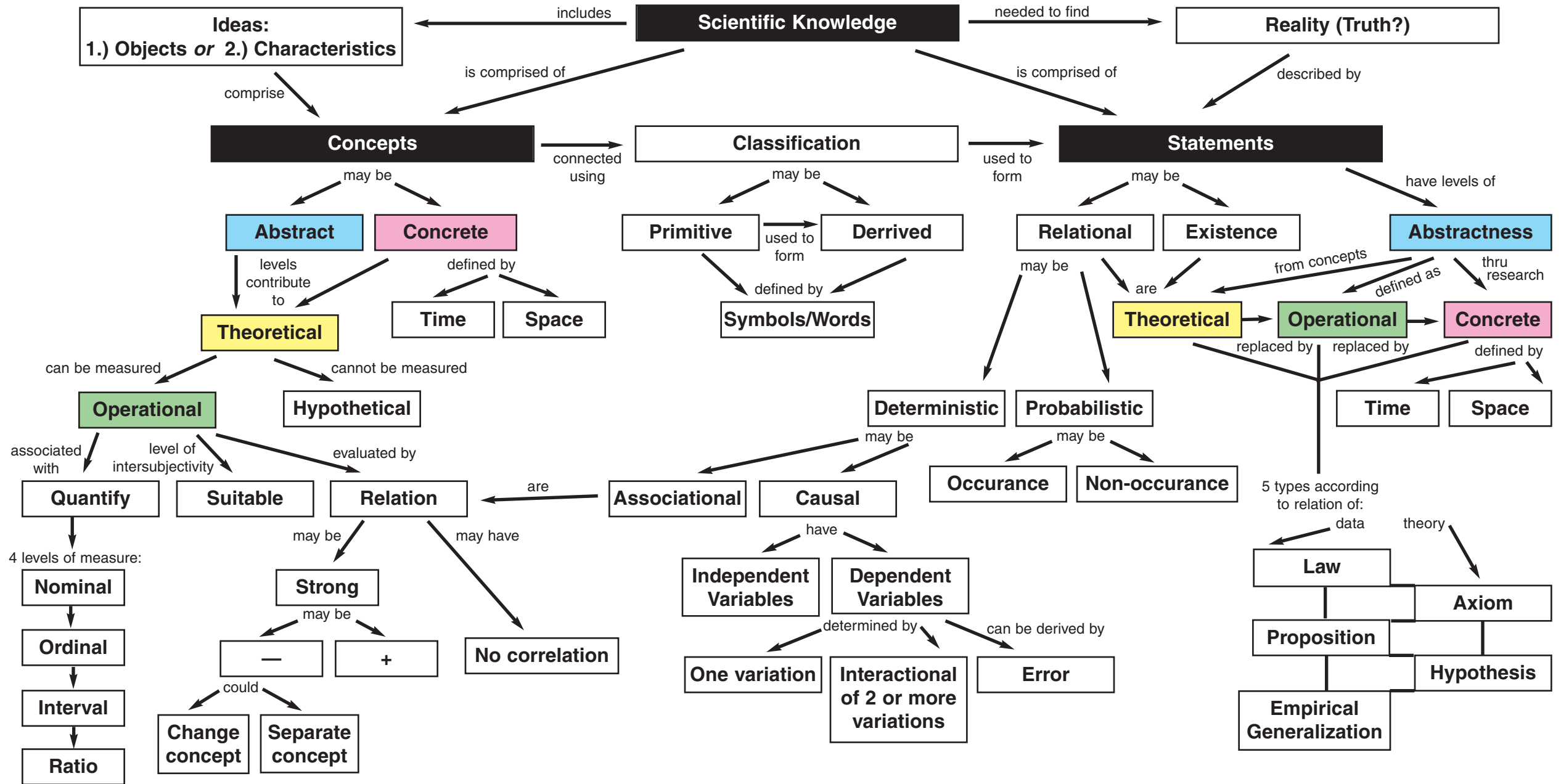


Concept Map* of Scientific Knowledge depicting the interrelationships of the core ideas in Chapters 3 & 4 in “A Primer in Theory Construction”
